

## Coaching Staff

### **Seth Tierney**

Hofstra Head Coach Seth Tierney has assembled a staff of coaches that include members of the Hofstra coaching staff, former Hofstra All Americans, a number of top college coaches, as well as many of the best college players in the game today.

In his 1<sup>st</sup> year as Head Coach of the Hofstra Pride is Seth Tierney. Coach Tierney returns to Hofstra after a six-year tenure at Johns Hopkins, the last two seasons as associate head coach. As the Blue Jays offensive coordinator, he was the architect of one of the most potent and explosive offenses in the nation in recent years. Tierney directed the Blue Jays attack that finished second in the nation in scoring margin, sixth in scoring offense and 16<sup>th</sup> in man-up offense during Hopkins' NCAA title run in 2005.

**Joe Amplo** is in his 5<sup>th</sup> year of his second tenure on the Hofstra University lacrosse staff. Amplo began his college coaching career in the fall of 1999 as a defensive specialist with the Hofstra midfielders. He has since served 4 seasons as an assistant coach under former head coach John Danowski , with the Pride advancing to the NCAA Championship Tournament 4 of the last 6 years.

**Matt Rewkowski** is in his 1<sup>st</sup> year on the Hofstra lacrosse staff. A 2005 graduate of Johns Hopkins, Rewkowski was an All-American midfielder for the Blue Jays and served as team captain on their 2005 National Championship team. He works primarily with the Pride offense and goaltenders.

**Ron Caputo** is in his fourth year on the Hofstra University men's lacrosse staff. Caputo joined the Pride in 2004 as a volunteer assistant from Syosset High school where he served as a varsity assistant lacrosse coach from 1997 through 2003.
